Suzann motioned for adjournment. Kyle seconded. Meeting adjourned.

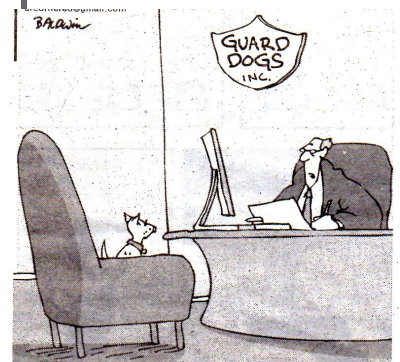
### PROGRAM

Dogs will do most anything we ask of them. The more we learn about canine structure, the more we understand what is reasonable to ask of our dogs, given their physical strengths and weaknesses.
